### **DESCRIPTION:**

FI310 is based on the certification standards and training programs for wildland fire investigators put in place by the National Wildfire Coordinating Group (NWCG). This program focuses on the investigation of complex wildland fire cases in a serial arson task force setting. The course is a combination of lecture, labs, and a practical exercise. In the labs and the final practical exercise, student teams will plan, analyze, organize, and conduct a complex serial arson investigation.
